

## Important Information for Wearers

The KeySafe program gives your Holder a **lot** of different ways to approach your chastity. Depending on your Holder's temperament, you may find the site being used simply to enforce chastity for a limited period, or to monitor your compliance, or to keep you constantly interacting with him/her via the site in search of an elusive permission. If you do not know what the site offers your Holder, you will find it difficult to please him/her.

The simplest thing your Holder may do is grant a straightforward permission. In that case, when you visit the **Keys** page you will be offered a permission, which you may decline or accept or return to later. Please note: if you fail to decide, your Holder can always revoke the permission while you are waiting!

Your Holder can also set one or more windows of opportunity for you. If you happen to check your **Keys** page when a window opens, you will be given the chance to accept or decline the permission. If you wait and the window closes then you have lost that opportunity. You should keep in mind that your Holder can set a window as short as *five minutes* or leave it open for hours. If you suspect your Holder has set a short window, you need to check in more frequently. When you miss a window, you will be notified as to when the missed window *closed* the next time you check-in on the **Keys** page. The program will *not* tell you how long the window was open.

Holders have the ability to set recurring windows. They can set as many repetitions as they want at one time and can make the windows occur at whatever frequency they want. A Holder could set 10 five-minute permission windows for you that repeat every 2 hours or they could set a 22-minute window that opens every week for 3 months. If your Holder sets this type of repeating window, you can figure out the frequency by subtracting the times each missed window closed and then try to find the next one by logging in to the **Keys** page around the next scheduled time.

However, some Keyholders may use the program sadistically to set recurring but somewhat random windows. A Holder may add a random time element of anywhere from a fraction of a minute to two hours. For example, a Holder could set a dozen windows roughly 24 hours apart; these could vary from being 23 to 25 hours apart and the random element would be different each time. If you suspect that your Holder has set one of these windows, then you will want to check every few minutes around the time you think the next window will open.

Another tool your Holder has is the ability to set a conditional window. Instead of getting a straightforward unlock when you find a permission (of any kind), your Holder may have you play a dice game with odds of success that he or she sets for you. If you win the game, you get the permission, if not, you have to wait for another chance. A very sadistic holder can set the program so that your chances of success drop with each missed window, so if you have this type of Holder, you should check in *very* often.

With all these tools at their disposal, a Holder can create the kind of chastity experience they enjoy. You can always ask your Holder how they are using these tools, but be warned. ...most won't answer you. Many Holders enjoy the control aspects of chastity even more than the denial and will get pleasure from shaping your behavior and making you interact with them and the site in the way they have designed.

If you suspect your Holder has set a window around a certain time, then please them by making a real effort to find the window. Your Holder knows *every* time you visit your **Keys** page, so he/she can track your efforts. If you have a sadistic Holder who has set short windows with a highly random element, the odds are that they want to see in your **History** file that you are constantly visiting around the time the window opens – even if they don't expect you to actually find the window. It is knowing that they have controlled your behavior and yet tormented you that give these Holders pleasure.

Many Holders (if not most) enjoy reading brief feedback on the experience they have created for you. For many, an occasional note in the message field when you find a window (or just miss one) is enough. Others prefer a regular e-mail in which you describe your end of the experience and thank them for guiding you through it.

Most of all, you should remember that Holders rarely take the effort to hold chastity keys just because they get a thrill out of pleasing strangers. They have to get something out of it too and the way they use the site is a signal as to what *they* want from the experience. If they show that they are really involved in your chastity, then you should show them that you are too. A sound approach is to take your cues from the way they use the above tools and try to give them the kind of pleasure they expect to get from holding your key.

## **Some Additional Thoughts About You and Your Keyholder**

There are a few things to consider when establishing a new keyholding relationship on the KeySafe site. Many chastity wearers have a fantasy of finding a person on the KeySafe site who will hold their key and control them. Both the chastity wearer and the Keyholder should be clear that they have the same vision of reality when using the KeySafe site or problems can occur. This section offers some hints and suggestions as to how both parties can get the most out of the site.

1. It is a fact that some Keyholders visit the site for a bit and then disappear forever. It is also sadly true that some Keyholders don't really care about their wearers and will keep your keys no matter what you do just because they enjoy the power.

For these reasons, the KeySafe site now has TWO features to help you limit (not eliminate) these risks. There is now a page titled "Takeback." Once a Holder accepts your keys, you have 6 days spread across the first month on which you can use the Takeback page to get your keys returned. These opportunities to withdraw your keys occur on the 7<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>, and 28<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup>, and 30<sup>th</sup> days after your keys are accepted. Think of this as a trial period during which both of you get to try out the keyholding relationship and see if the fit works. The days you can withdraw your keys have been spread out so that both of you can get a taste of what it is like for the Holder to control your keys and you can NOT back out whenever you want.

However, you should note that your history file would show that you withdrew the keys (which holders will not like to see) so you should make every effort to work out any issues with the Holder before withdrawing your keys. Also, if a Holder does not log on to the site at least once every 30 days, you will have the option to have your keys returned. This is not automatic; you must actively withdraw the keys. For example, if you and your Holder have taken control off-line or she has been unavailable but everything is going smoothly you would just ignore the option.

2. If it looks like you two have quite different visions of chastity and it is past the trial period, you should ask that your key be returned. The responsible Keyholder will quickly return the key.

3. It makes sense to do a few tests with your Keyholder using the KeySafe site before really getting started with serious keyholding. The Keyholder has a lot of possibilities available on her Keys page as we saw above. In all likelihood, this is all new to her and doing a couple of run throughs so she can see how things work and how they look on both her Keys screen and your history file will make it much more likely that the tools on the KeySafe site will be used creatively and increase the enjoyment for both of you.
4. Of course, you can use the KeySafe as a complete fantasy tool and only pretend to put on your chastity device. However, the more real you make the power exchange using the site, the more dependent you will be on your Keyholder. You may get very submissive or you may get very desperate, but in any case, you should treat your Keyholder with great respect and not go outside the bounds that you have negotiated.

The longer a chastity relationship continues, the more important the Keyholder becomes to the wearer. There can be a temptation to ask for more attention or reassurance and you should be careful not to be a pest. Communicate with your Keyholder if the loss of control is getting to be too psychologically (or physically) intense. Unless your Keyholder is in chastity themselves, they probably have no idea how intense every minute in chastity can be. They can tune out their keyholding whenever they want; you are a wearer 24/7 and can't escape from it whenever you want. Don't get angry with your Keyholder if they don't seem to get what you are going through, they probably don't! Instead, take any opportunities you are given to clearly communicate what you are going through to your Keyholder. It will make for a better experience for you both.
